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#### Independent Auditor's Report

To the Members of Winter River-Tracadie Bay Watershed Association Inc.

#### 1. Significant Accounting Policies

#### Nature and Purpose of Organization

Winter River-Tracadie Bay Watershed Association Inc. is primarily involved in watershed management. The Association is a not-for-profit organization and is exempt from income taxes in accordance with certain provisions of the Income Tax Act.

#### **Basis of Accounting**
